In Defense of Knowledge from Falsehood

Can inferential knowledge be acquired from a false premise? Several authors have described cases that arguably illustrate the possibility of this kind of knowledge from falsehood (KFF). In a recent paper, however, Martin Montminy argues that KFF is impossible. I will offer a response to Montminy's arguments and highlight the costs of denying KFF by appeal to so-called 'proxy premise' strategies.
