

## How to get to LKH having arrived in Manchester

**BY TAXI:** there are taxi ranks by the main rail stations and at the airport.

**BY BUS:** *From the Airport:* Number 43 bus leaves from the terminal situated next to the railway station. It travels along Wilmslow road and stops near the end of Brighton grove, opposite 'Platt Fields'. A time table for the bus is attached.

*From Piccadilly Station:* On the main concourse of the station, turn right at the exit onto London Road and continue walking along the street for 5-10 minutes until you reach Portland Street. Here you will have reached Piccadilly Gardens within the City Centre and you will find the main bus and tram links on your left. From Piccadilly Gardens, you will need to catch any bus route with the numbers 40 or 140 (eg. 41, 42, 43, 141, 142, 42X). Once on the bus you will need to alight opposite Platt Fields (driver destination). The journey takes approximately 20 minutes, but can take up to 30 minutes in heavier traffic. Nearing the end of your bus journey you will pass through Rusholme/The Curry Mile and also a large white pub on your left called Hardys Well. At the pub, you will need to alight at the next stop. At the bus stop, walk along Wilmslow Road you will see a large white building with a sign for Abbey Solicitors. After the solicitors, turn next left onto Brighton Grove. The drive/entrance to Luther King House is 120 yards along Brighton Grove on your left.

*From Manchester Oxford Road:* Walk down from the main exit of the station and cross over to the bus stops outside the Manchester Palace Hotel. From here, you will need to catch one of the buses listed above. Once on the bus, follow the same directions as above.

**BY CAR:** Luther King House is a 20 minute car journey from Junction 3 of the M602 (directly leading from the end of the M62) and all roads are well signposted. From the M602, follow the A57 and Mancunian Way for 2.2miles, and join the A5067 (Cambridge Street). At the end of Cambridge Street, turn left onto Booth Street until you reach the traffic lights at the Royal Northern College of Music (RNCM). Turn right at the traffic lights and continue along Oxford Road/Wilmslow Road (B5117) for 1.5 miles. Nearing the end of your journey you will pass through Rusholme/The Curry Mile and also a large white pub on your left called Hardys Well. On your right, you will then see Platt Fields Park; on your left you will see the large white building of Abbey Solicitors. Turn right after the solicitors and the drive/entrance to Luther King House is 120 yards on your left.
