Free places in Direct Grant and Independent Schools

You will know that because you asked that your child should be considered for one of my Committee's free places at the above-named school, he has taken certain tests for my Committee. I am now able to let you know that he has qualified to be considered for a free place.

The selection of the children to be given the limited number of free places will be made next term and I will let you know, in due course, whether or not your son is to be offered one of these places. The reasons which you have given for naming the school as your first choice for your son will be taken into account when the selection is made. I must stress, however, that the number of candidates for free places is very much in excess of the number of places to be given and you should not assume that your son will, in fact, be offered a free place. If he is not, a place will be offered for him in a comprehensive school where there will be every opportunity for him to follow a suitable course.
