Blog – Rules of Procedure

Purpose

The Manchester SIAM Student Chapter Blog is intended as an opportunity for members of the Manchester SIAM Student Chapter (Chapter hereafter) to communicate their research in applied mathematics and computational science to a wider audience.

Blog posts

A blog post should be a piece of expository writing, which is aimed at discussing research-related matter to a general audience in an enjoyable and non-technical way.

The content can be a summary or a review of a research paper, poster, talk or a book, or a more general examination of a research area within the scope of applied mathematics and computational science. The length of a single post should not exceed a maximum of 500 words including code and captions. No limit is set for the length of bibliographical items.

Authors

All members of the Chapter can submit blog post proposals.

Editors

The editorial board is formed by the members of the Chapter committee and by staff members. For the academic year 2015/2016 the coordinator of the editorial board is Mante Zemaityte (mante.zemaityte@manchester.ac.uk).

Editorial process

Proposals for new blog posts should be sent to (manchestersiam.blog@gmail.com). Before being posted, any blog post shall be reviewed by two members of the editorial board, with the aim of assessing the quality of the submission. In case inaccuracies are found, the author shall be given a chance to correct or improve his or her submission.
